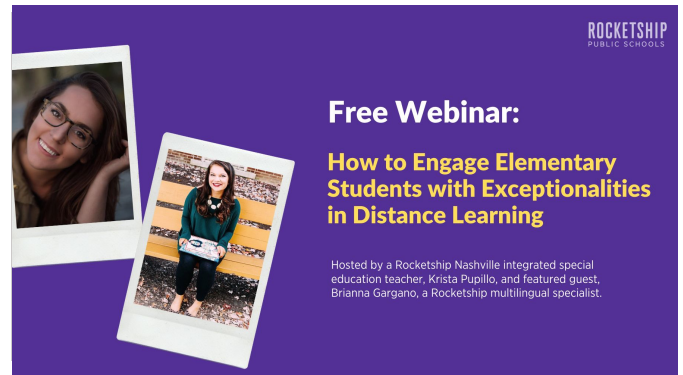

Virtual Teaching Tips for General Accommodations

- [Provide directions in multiple formats:](#) Use pictures, verbal, and video instructions to demonstrate to the student what you are expecting their work to look like.
- Multiple modes of response
- Provide access to the text
- Audio recording of texts and directions
- Repetitive assignment format
- [Annotation:](#) For younger grades, this may mean highlighting sight words or words with a specific phonics pattern. For upper grades, this may mean highlighting significant dates or other important details.
- Guided work-time
