SECTION B: CONTRACT TYPE, PRODUCTS OR SERVICES & PRICE/COST

B.1 OVERVIEW

1. [Rocketship Public Schools](#) in the Bay Area is seeking a Distributor to furnish equipment for food service with products and delivery to [thirteen \(13\)](#) school sites participating in the Child Nutrition Programs The successful bidder shall deliver in accordance with the requirements for each applicable program.
2. The purpose of this solicitation is to award a contract to provide equipment for meals served at [Rocketship Public Schools](#) herein referred to as the School Food Authority or SFA.
3. SFA agrees to provide Distributor with the pricing sheet (Schedule C) including the estimated quantities, attached.

B.2 SPECIFICATIONS

1. Bids are to be submitted on the specified products included. Failure to adhere to the SFA's requirements may result in cancellation of contract.
2. Bidders shall indicate for each item bid the name and model of the brand being bid. [Rocketship Public Schools](#) has provided an initial specification. This is done to provide the bidder with information regarding the nature and quality of the materials required and is not meant to restrict bidding to that particular brand. However, if the item bid varies from the one described; descriptive written details for the product to sufficiently describe the equipment for evaluation must accompany the submitted bid. A specification sheet of the piece of equipment the bidder is offering will need to be provided for each item in this bid when bidder is not bidding the originally specified item. Bids received without this information or with insufficient information, as determined by [Rocketship Public Schools](#), will not be considered. If the bidder does not indicate that an item proposed to be furnished is other than specified, the specified item shall be supplied by the bidder upon issuance of a purchase order. Once an item is awarded from this bid to a successful bidder, no substitution of brands will be permitted.
3. All bid items shall include equipment's base price, disconnection of existing equipment (as necessary, installation, freight/shipping, and any necessary equipment removal cost. The vendor shall provide lead time for delivery and installation once a purchase order has been issued.
4. Awarded vendors shall be responsible for activating all manufacturer warranties. All warranty information will be forwarded to Rocketship's Director of Foodservice.
5. Please see equipment description of required Voltage/Electrical supply.

6. Bid prices must be firm for one hundred twenty (120) days from date of award for bid to be considered, unless otherwise noted.
7. An awarded vendor will coordinate delivery and installation with [Rocketship Public Schools](#). At no time will the vendor access a school campus without approval or knowledge.
8. Quantities are estimates only and may be subject to change. [Rocketship Public Schools](#) reserves the right to increase or decrease quantities as necessary.

B.3 REQUIREMENTS REGARDING PRICING, BIDDING, AND ORDERING

Bidders are asked to submit prices on all items as outlined in **Section B.2** and **Schedule C** to be delivered to all the schools on the designated days and times as stated in Schedule A.

1. Basis and Award of Bid

Bidders shall submit their bids on an “all or none” basis. Except as otherwise provided in this solicitation, if a contract is awarded as a result of this solicitation, it will bind the SFA during the term of the contract to secure all its needs from the successful bidder. Such contract shall bind the Distributor to perform all such work ordered by the SFA at prices specified in the contract. Award will be made to a responsive, responsible bidder(s) on the basis of the lowest aggregated cost to the SFA.

2. Requirements Contract

- a) This is a requirements contract for the products and services specified in the IFB and attachments for the period set forth therein. The quantities or such services specified herein are estimates only and are not purchased hereby. In the event the SFA’s requirements for products, set forth in, do not result in orders in the amounts or quantities described as “estimated” in the IFB and attachments, except as may be otherwise provided herein, such event shall not constitute the basis for an equitable price adjustment under this contract.
- b) The SFA shall not be required to purchase from the Distributor requirements in excess of the limit on total orders under this contract, if any.

3. Pricing

Pricing shall be on products which meet the specifications as required by the SFA and as listed in Schedule C (the Pricing Sheet). Bid price must include price of products, transportation, and all other related costs. Distributor will not invoke any additional charges for emergency orders (defined as an order that is placed for same day delivery).

4. Product Orders

SFAs will order all items at once and set a delivery schedule for all items by 8/1/2024. Scheduled deliveries will occur between 8 AM and 4 PM. Deliveries will include delivery, installation, removal of previous equipment, and disposal of packaging.

B.4 SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 1) This is an Invitation for Bid (IFB), which means that it is a formal method of procurement in which sealed bids are publicly solicited, resulting in the award of a firm fixed-price contract to the responsible bidder(s) whose bid is responsive to the IFB, will conform with all the material conditions of the Invitation for Bid and at the sole discretion of the SFA is deemed to be most advantageous to the SFA, with price being the primary consideration among responsive and responsible bidders.
- 2) Bidders are expected to examine carefully the specifications, schedules, attachments, terms, and conditions of this IFB. Failure to do so shall result in an incomplete bid.
- 3) Bidders must submit an electronic copy. If accepted, this IFB will become the contract and one copy of the contract will be forwarded to the successful bidder with the notice of award. Bidders are not allowed to change specifications or general conditions, and bidders shall initial any erasures on this bid prior to submission.
- 4) Pricing must be provided per unit with itemized bid pricing for base price of equipment, shipping, disconnecting existing equipment for placement of new equipment, installation and removal of old equipment contingent upon SFA's need for removal. Bidder must provide estimated lead time for every item submitted. Estimated totals must be carried out to the second decimal place and must not be rounded. In any case of errors in the extension of the estimated total(s), the actual unit rates shall govern.

SECTION C: SPECIFICATIONS / WORK STATEMENT

C.1 SCOPE

Rocketship Public Schools is seeking a Distributor to furnish equipment related to serving meals to children participating in the Child Nutrition Programs

1. Distributor agrees to deliver products to locations set out in **Schedule A**, attached hereto, and made a part hereof, subject to the terms and conditions of this solicitation.

SECTION D: GENERAL CONDITIONS

D.1 DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS

- a) The Distributor shall deliver only items and quantities ordered by the SFA and as specified under Section B of the contract.
- b) Products shall be delivered on scheduled delivery dates to the delivery sites (see Schedule A), unloaded, and placed in the designated areas at each school site by the distributor's personnel at each of the locations and times listed in Schedule A.
- c) The Distributor shall place all deliveries in a location assigned by person (s) designated by the SFA. Deliveries will not be accepted at the entrance of the facility.
- d) The Distributor shall be responsible for delivery of all products at the specified delivery windows.
- e) The SFA reserves the right to add or delete sites so long as that addition or deletion does not result in a material change (i.e., the value of the additional goods will not exceed 10% of the value of the contract). This shall be done by amendment of Schedule A. Deletion or addition of sites shall be made not less than one week prior to the required state of service. Any change in transportation cost that occurs as a result of adding or deleting sites shall be negotiated and noted in the modification. The distributor's invoice shall show the cost as a separate item for that site.
- f) If a scheduled delivery cannot be executed for any reason, the Distributor shall immediately notify the SFA designated representative. The Distributor shall provide SFA with the reason for non-delivery. If the reason is accepted, the SFA designee shall give the Distributor an alternate delivery date, which shall satisfy the needs at the site(s) missed in the delivery process. The Distributor shall be required to deliver only quantities for which an order was made by SFA prior to delivery.

- g) The Distributor shall not make deliveries to [Rocketship Public Schools](#) on Saturday, Sunday, or on school and legal holidays unless specified otherwise.

SECTION G: INSURANCE

G.1 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The Distributor shall procure and maintain, during the entire period of performance under this contract, the types of insurance specified below. The Distributor shall have its insurance broker or insurance company submit a Certificate of Insurance to the SFA giving evidence of the required coverage prior to commencing performance under this contract. In no event shall any work be performed until the required Certificates of Insurance signed by an authorized representative of the insurer(s) have been provided to, and accepted by, the SFA. All insurance shall be written with financially responsible companies authorized to do business in California or in the jurisdiction where the work is to be performed and have an A.M. Best Company rating of A-VIII or higher. The Distributor shall require all of its subcontractors to carry the same insurance required herein. The Distributor shall ensure that all policies provide that the SFA shall be given thirty (30) days prior written notice in the event the stated limit in the declarations page of the policy is reduced via endorsement or the policy is canceled prior to the expiration date shown on the certificate. The Distributor shall provide the SFA with ten (10) days prior written notice in the event of non-payment of premium.

G.2 COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE

The Distributor shall provide evidence satisfactory to the SFA with respect to the services performed that it carries \$1,000,000 per occurrence limits; \$2,000,000 aggregate; Bodily Injury and Property Damage including, but not limited to: premises-operations; broad form property damage; Products and Completed Operations; Personal and Advertising Injury; contractual liability and independent contractors. The Distributor shall maintain Completed Operations coverage for five (5) years following final acceptance of the work performed under this contract.

G.3 AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY INSURANCE

The Distributor shall provide automobile liability insurance to cover all owned, hired or non-owned motor vehicles used in conjunction with the performance of this contract. The policy shall provide a \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage.

G.4 WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE

The Distributor shall provide Workers' Compensation insurance in accordance with the statutory mandates of California or the jurisdiction in which the contract is performed.

G.5 EMPLOYER'S LIABILITY INSURANCE

The Distributor shall provide employer's liability insurance as follows: \$500,000 per accident for injury; \$500,000 per employee for disease; and \$500,000 for policy disease limit.

SECTION H: INSTRUCTIONS, CONDITIONS, AND NOTICES TO BIDDERS

H.1 METHOD OF AWARD

1. **Rocketship Public Schools** reserves the right to accept/reject any/all bids resulting from this solicitation. The SFA may reject all bids or waive any minor informality or irregularity in bids received whenever it is determined that such action is in the best interest of the District.

SECTION I: PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF BIDS

1. The SFA may reject as non-responsive any bid that fails to conform in any material respect to the IFB.
2. The SFA may also reject as non-responsive any bids submitted on forms not included in or required by the solicitation. Bidders shall make no changes to the requirements set forth in the solicitation.
3. The bidder must bid on all Contract Line Item Numbers (CLINs) to be considered for this award. Failure to bid on all CLINs may render the bid non-responsive and disqualify a bid.
4. The bidders shall complete, sign and submit all Representations, Certifications and Acknowledgments as appropriate. Failure to do so may result in a bid rejection.

SECTION J: QUESTIONS ABOUT THE SOLICITATION

If a prospective bidder has any questions relative to this solicitation, the prospective bidder shall submit the question electronically to Kelly Giampaoli at kgiampaoli@rsed.org. The prospective bidder should submit questions no later than 10 days prior to the closing date and time indicated for this solicitation. The SFA may not consider any questions received less than 10 days before the date set for submission of bids. The SFA will furnish responses to the Distributor contact's e-mail address. An amendment to the solicitation will be issued if the SFA decides that information is necessary in submitting bids, or if the lack of it would be prejudicial to any prospective bidder. Oral explanations or instructions given by SFA officials before the award of the contract will not be binding.

ERRORS IN BIDS

Bidders are expected to read and understand fully all information and requirements contained in the solicitation; failure to do so will be at the bidder's risk. In event of a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price, the unit price shall govern.
